Meet the overall and science GPA requirements of 3.5 or higher at time of application. This form must be filled out by the student candidate and confirmed by an undergraduate academic advisor or pre-health advisor.

Complete at least 45 credit hours towards bachelor's degree at the time of application.

Earn at least 60 credit hours at a four-year institution by the of graduation.

Earn at least 30 credit hours completed at ECU.

Complete 15 of the final 30 credit hours or 50% of the upper-division hours in the major field completed at East Central University.

Complete, prior to the first day of medical school at OSU-COM, all other degree requirements for the undergraduate degree, including the undergraduate general education requirements, college requirements, and all major and minor-supported requirements of a OSU-COM 3+1 program are eligible for a bachelor's degree option at East Central University; *except* courses approved by the advisor and department head that may be substituted for electives or major requirements per the specific ECU catalog and degree plan.
